

BEFORE ATTEMPTING TO USE THE HYDRAULIC LIFT ACTION ON THIS BED, THE BED MUST BE FULLY ASSEMBLED AND COMPLETE WITH MATTRESS IN PLACE. IF YOU TRY THE MECHANISM BEFORE THE BED IS FULLY ASSEMBLED, IT MAY APPEAR STIFF AND REQUIRE MORE FORCE TO OPERATE.

PLEASE READ this sheet prior to assembly to familiarise yourself with the various stages of constructi Carefully open the pack supplied and check the contents against the parts and fitting check list.


- This product is intended for a maximum person's weight of 100kg per side. Do not exceed this weight.

#### **CARE INFORMATION**


- Never use scourers, abrasives or chemical cleaners.
- To clean wipe with a sponge and warm soapy water. Do not use solvent based cleaners or detergents as they can bleach or damage the product.
- If the bed being used is on a wooden or laminate floor. We recommend the use of furniture friction pads. These can be bought from most reputable DIY store.


Place all parts on a even clean surface such as a carpet or the packing cardboard this will help to protect them against scratching or damage

Please count all parts to ensure they are all there BEFORE starting to Assemble the bed



## Step1:

Attaching side rails
A: Position left side rail(3)
adjacent to headboard(1)
so that the holes in the
headboard line up with the
bracket on the side rail.
Secure in place using 3
bolts(A), spring washers
(F) and flat washers(G)
using the allen key provided.



B: Repeat point A for right side rail(4).




### Step2:

#### **Attaching footboard**


Place footboard (2) in position at the end of the side rails (3) & (4) so the holes in the footboard line up with the brackets on the side rail.



Secure in place using 3 bolts (A), spring washers (F) and flat washers (G) using the allen key provided.



Before tightening the bolts, please ensure the bed frame is square.





### Step3:

Fix corner brackets

Fix corner bracket(9) in position between the left side rail(3) and headboard (1) using bolt(B).


Repeat for other 3 corner brackets in each corner of the bed frame.



### Step4:

Fix holding block

Fix holding block (10) onto footboard (2) using bolt (E) and tighten using allen key.


#### Step5:

Secure hydraulic arms

Before connecting the hydraulic arm, ensure the lifting mechanism is functioning correctly - it should lift up and down freely with adequate clearance on all sides.

Please ensure the hydraulic arm is in the correct position. The thinner section should be attached to the side rail, and the thicker section is connected to the slat frame.

Once you have fitted the hydraulic arms to the bed, the bed will remain elevated until you complete assembly, once you have completed assembly refer to the front page of the instructions titled 'how to use the bed'



Secure the hydraulic lifting mechanisms on the side rails (3) & (4) into place by using nuts (C) as shown.

Do not overtighten the nuts.


#### Step6:

#### Assemble the base

A: Fix the front/back frame rails(5) to the side support rails which are already attached to the lifting mechanism with plastic brackets (8).

Repeat on all four corners.

B: Fix centre frame rail (7) to front / back frame rails (5) using bolt (B) and tighten with allen key provided.



#### Step7:


Attach the horizontal supports

Fix the horizontal support rails (6) on the bottom of the lifting mechanism rail using bolts (D) with the allen key provided.

## Step8:

A: Attach woven fabric


Turn bed on its side and attach woven fabric (16) to base.



B: Attach adjustable legs

Whilst bed is upside down attach adjustable legs (11) to the base and tighten them.





## Step9: Assemble slats


Attach centre slat caps (15) and side slat caps (14) to each slat (13) as shown.

Attach the slats to the slat frame by firmly pushing into place on the slat frame.



### Step10:

Attach belt (12) to the metal frame by loop-on method as shown. pull tight after loop-on.
